The bibliography lists monographs, edited books and main articles which as their main topic describe and analyse the global spread of Hindu traditions in antiquity and modern times. At times a synonymous treatment of "Indian" and "Hindu" had been unavoidable though this usage does not imply that all Indians are necessarily Hindus. The same applies for the usage of "South Asian".
