

Paul To Timothy: An Epistle



As part of our Letters to the Church series, we're taking a brief look at each epistle in the New Testament. Last week we looked at Paul's letter to the First Letter of St. Paul to Timothy is preceded by Second Thessalonians, and followed by his Second Letter to Timothy in the New Testament of the Bible. In the New Testament, the Second Epistle of Paul to Timothy, usually referred to simply as Second Timothy and often written 2 Timothy or II Timothy, is one of the. This second letter to Timothy was probably written in 66 or Conybeare and Howson, in their book The Life and Epistles of St. Paul, date Paul's death as May.
